The purpose of this program is to provide intensive training in the areas of entrepreneurship, civic engagement and job skills development for the next generation of leaders and creative thinkers in Austin. Youth will learn from mentors who are experts in their fields, engage in high level training for business owners and learn firsthand how to successfully establish, operate and staff a company of their own.

4. What are the five best & worst things about Austin?
5. Who is your hero (outside of family member)? Explain why.

Village Fellows Code of Conduct

Providing an environment for open, respectful, and safe communication is the top priority for the Village Community Fellows Program. Our goal is to allow Fellows, staff, and other program participants to share and exchange ideas and perspectives as well as collaborate on meaningful and impactful projects for the Austin Community.

For this purpose, the Village Community Fellows Program has implemented a Code of Conduct setting forth the expectations of Fellows and their responsibilities and obligations to participate in the program.

Each Fellow receives the Code of Conduct and is asked to review and agree to it before participating in the fellowship program. Among other things, the Code of Conduct requires respect for peers, speakers, and other program participants, timeliness, and cultural sensitivity and adaptability. If a Fellow does not fulfill any of these obligations, the Code of Conduct permits Village Community Fellows Program to remediate the issue.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS

Village Community Fellows Program is committed to providing an environment that is respectful to all those involved in its programming. This Code of Conduct describes Village Community Fellows Program's expectations for Fellows' behavior throughout their time in the programs.

Respect for Peers

Village Community Fellows Program expects Fellows to approach each other with respect. Fellows must approach discussions with maturity, honesty and an openness to explore their own perspectives and those of others.

Respect for Speakers

Village Community Fellows Program expects Fellows to approach speakers with respect and with a desire to learn – even from speakers with whom they strongly disagree.

Cultural Sensitivity and Adaptability

Fellows must be sensitive to cultural differences and recognize that some of the behaviors that they may find uncomfortable pertain to a different cultural context. Although cultural misunderstandings may occur – during and outside the program – Fellows should always show respect and a willingness to understand these cultural differences.

Timeliness

Fellows are expected to attend each scheduled session at the designated time. Should a Fellow need to be late, the Fellow should contact program staff in advance. Program staff may excuse absences on a case-by-case basis. Persistent lateness or absences will not be tolerated and could result in dismissal from the program.

Alcohol and Drug Usage

Fellows must follow the laws governing alcohol and drug usage in the country of their program. Fellows found breaking those laws may face local legal consequences and/or dismissal from the program. Village Community Fellows Program strongly discourages the use of drugs and irresponsible and excessive alcohol consumption during the program. Fellows are ambassadors of Village Community Fellows Program and should demonstrate appropriate behavior.

Harassment

Village Community Fellows Program is committed to providing an environment where people can interact comfortably and free from any form of harassment, sexual or otherwise. Such offensive behavior may relate to race, gender, religion, national origin or other protected statuses. Village Community Fellows Program prohibits offensive behavior and remarks in the program involving Village Community Fellows Program Fellows, staff, interns, visitors, speakers and/or third parties. Reported cases of harassment will be promptly investigated by Village Community Fellows Program. Fellows who are found to have engaged in acts of harassment are subject to penalty including dismissal from the program and legal action.
